READING AND CHANGING BOOKS

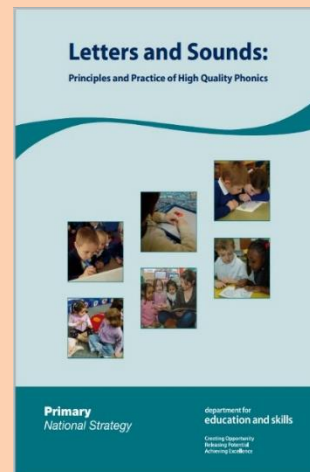


- ◉ Please read with your children everyday and please comment/sign their reading record each week.
- ◉ Reading does not have to only be the books from school. Chn can read books they have at home and also books that they get from the library.
- ◉ We will change their books at school once a week.
- ◉ The children need to be secure with the comprehension relating to any book.



PHONICS

- Letters and Sounds - Contains games and activities we use to help children with phonics. Available online for FREE.
- Children are taught to read by breaking down words into separate **sounds** or '**phonemes**'. They are then taught how to **blend** these sounds together to read the whole word.
- Children have a 20 minute daily phonics lesson every morning.
- Children will be assessed each half term using past phonics papers. In Summer term there will be a Phonics screening test.



HOW CAN YOU HELP?



Children can practise their phonics by playing games online.

- Neat handwriting
- Letter formations
- Capital letters
- Finger spaces
- Full stops
- Writing on the line
- Joining words and joining clauses using 'and' and 'because'
- Using a capital letter for names of people, places, the days of the week, and the personal pronoun 'I'
- Discuss what they have written with the teacher or other pupils
