Secondary School Applications for Year 6 Pupils

Please ensure that you visit the secondary school of your choice on the relevant open days/evenings over the next few weeks. Information is available on each school's website. Secondary School application forms should be completed online by logging on to www.redbridge.gov.uk/eAdmissions

<u>Universal Free School Meals</u>: All primary school children in state-funded schools in London will receive Universal free school meals for the 2023/24 school year.

In addition to the above, we encourage parents who are in receipt of any of the following benefits to apply for FSM. These include:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit

Universal Credit - if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household earnings must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

With this entitlement you <u>may</u> be eligible to other support packages ie:

- Food vouchers each term
- Household support fund
- · Funding breakfast clubs
- The Holiday Activity Food programmes (HAF is funded by the government and run by the councils who help deliver the holiday clubs)
- This will also provide extra funding to the school to support vulnerable pupils and improve education outcomes.

If you were not entitled to have a Free School Meal entitlement previously and your financial circumstances have changed, please ask at the office for a form to complete.

The office will assist you in your applying for the FSM entitlement should you be eligible and need any assistance with it.

Flu Vaccinations on Friday 10th and Monday 27th November 2023: Dear Parents We have the following dates for the flu vaccination which will take place on Friday 10th November and Monday 27th November 2023 for all the children from Reception through to year 6 Please find the link below for the E-consent form. Please note that the portal shuts 2 days before the session so it is important parents complete the form as soon as possible. This year, your child will be offered the nasal spray as well as the gelatine free alternative which is an injection. The nasal spray is more effective for young people however, if any parent wishes for their child to receive the flu injection instead of the nasal spray, they will need to consent to the vaccination and then they are given the option of nasal spray or injection. The use of e -consent means that parents are notified that their child has been vaccinated immediately at the point of care.
